Seiriol is a writer, performer, director and musician coming from a live art background: in this medium he has presented self-devised work at Modern Art Oxford, The Courtauld Institute, The De La Warr Pavillion and Duckie! among others. He won Oxford University's Mitzi Cunliffe Sculpture Prize 2003 for a performance at the Oxford Botanical Gardens.

He is on a committee member and workshop leader of Beatabet (beatabet.net), which runs creative communes for an international and inter-disciplinary pool of musicians and artists. Beatabet is currently the subject of a BBC Wales documentary. The song "Sexy Gotterdammerung", written and recorded with Beatabet, came runner up in the British Academy of Composers and Songwriters' Songwriting Contest 2006 (www.britishacademy.com).

Seiriol is a core member of the theatre company BoileRoom. Last year, thanks to development time awarded by the Playground, BoileRoom were awarded the Oxford Samuel Beckett Theatre Trust Award 2007 (www.osbtrust.com). Their production, "The Terrific Electric" will be staged at the Barbican Pit in Sept 2007.
